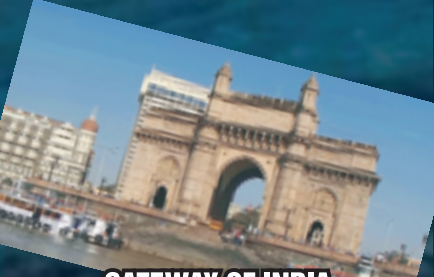

The name Mumbai is derived from Mumbadevi, the local incarnation of the Devi (Mother Goddess). Bombay is an anglicized version of the Portuguese name 'Bom Bahia' meaning 'Good Bay'.



**THE ELEPHANTA CAVES**  
They are a collection of cave temples predominantly dedicated to the Hindu God, Shiva. They are on Elephanta Island or Gharapuri in Mumbai harbour.



**GATEWAY OF INDIA**  
It was erected to commemorate the landing of King George V and Queen Mary in 1911. The last British troops to leave India following the country's Independence passed through the Gateway on their way out on 28th February 1948.



**CHHATRAPATI SHIVAJI MAHARAJ SANGHRALAYA**  
It was originally named Prince of Wales Museum of Western India. It has approximately 50000 exhibits of ancient Indian history as well as objects from foreign lands. The museum was renamed in 1988, after Shivaji Maharaj, the founder of the Maratha Empire.



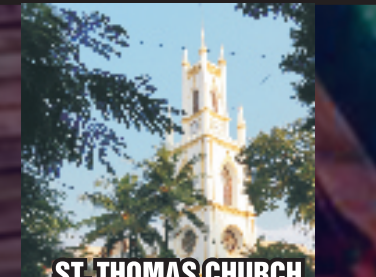
**RAJABAI CLOCK TOWER**  
It was designed and modelled by Sir George Gilbert Scott in the lines of the Big Ben in London. It was financed by a Mumbai based cotton businessman, Premchand Roychand. He wanted to build a clock as a tribute to his blind mother (thus, named Rajabai after her) and to remind her to take her meals on time.



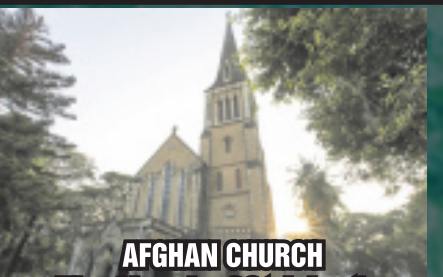
**ASIATIC LIBRARY**  
The Asiatic Society of Mumbai (formerly Asiatic Society of Bombay), is a learned society in the field of Asian studies. It was founded on 26 November 1804 by Sir James Macintosh.



**CHHATRAPATI SHIVAJI MAHARAJ TERMINUS (CSMT)**  
The Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus formerly known as Victoria Terminus was designed in 1853 and built in 1888 in a Gothic-revival style. In March 1996, the terminus name was changed from Victoria Terminus to Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus after Shivaji Maharaj, the 17th Century warrior King.



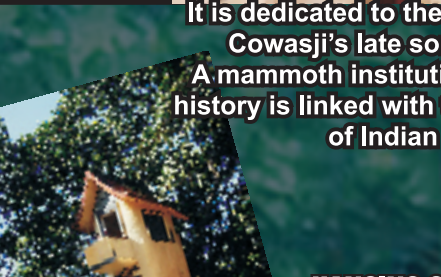
**ST. THOMAS CHURCH**  
St. Thomas Cathedral, Mumbai, is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Mumbai of the Church of North India. The 300-year-old church is the oldest church in Mumbai. The Cathedral and John Connon School is run by the cathedral.



**AFGHAN CHURCH**  
The Church of St John the Evangelist, better known as the Afghan Church, is a church of Anglican heritage, that belongs to the Mumbai diocese of the Church of North India. It was built by the British between 1847 and 1858 to commemorate the dead of the First Afghan War and the disastrous 1842 retreat from Kabul.



**HAJIALI DARGA**  
Situating against the backdrop of the splendid Arabian sea, the mosque appears like an imaginary world floating on the water. Owing to its unique and striking location, the road to the mosque gets submerged in the water during high tide, making it inaccessible.



**HANGING GARDEN**  
The Hanging Gardens are terraced gardens perched at the top of Malabar Hill. The park was designed and laid out in 1881 by Ulhas Ghapkar over Bombay's main reservoir.



**KAHHERI CAVES**  
Located in Sanjay Gandhi National Park, they are a collection of rock cut monuments, prayer halls and buildings created by Buddhist monks. They are carved in a single hill of basalt known as Krishna Giri (meaning Black Mountain). A total of 109 caves were carved from the dense basalt stone of the hillside.



**NEHRU SCIENCE CENTRE**  
It is the largest interactive science center in India. The center opened its first semi-permanent exhibition 'between light and sight' in 1977 followed by the world's first ever Science Park in 1979, during the International Year of the child.



**BHAU DAJI LAD**  
It is the oldest museum in Mumbai situated in the vicinity of Byculla zoo. It was named as 'The Victoria and Albert Museum'. Later in November 1975, it was renamed as Dr. Bhau Daji Lad Museum in honor of the man whose vision and dedication enabled its establishment.



**TARAPOREWALA AQUARIUM**  
Taraporewala Aquarium is India's oldest aquarium and one of Mumbai's main attractions. It hosts marine and freshwater fish. The aquarium has a 12-foot long and 180 degree acrylic glass tunnel. The fish are kept in large glass tanks, lit with LED lights.



**JEHANGIR ART GALLERY**

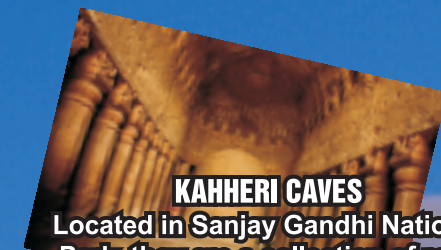
**AFGHAN CHURCH**

St. Thomas Cathedral, Mumbai, is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Mumbai of the Church of North India. The 300-year-old church is the oldest church in Mumbai. The Cathedral and John Connon School is run by the cathedral.



**AFGHAN CHURCH**  
The Church of St John the Evangelist, better known as the Afghan Church, is a church of Anglican heritage, that belongs to the Mumbai diocese of the Church of North India. It was built by the British between 1847 and 1858 to commemorate the dead of the First Afghan War and the disastrous 1842 retreat from Kabul.



**HAJALI DARGA**  
Situating against the backdrop of the splendid Arabian sea, the mosque appears like an imaginary world floating on the water. Owing to its unique and striking location, the road to the mosque gets submerged in the water during high tide, making it inaccessible.



**HANGING GARDEN**  
The Hanging Gardens are terraced gardens perched at the top of Malabar Hill. The park was designed and laid out in 1881 by Ulhas Ghapkar over Bombay's main reservoir.
